

## Wenonah Family Safe in Hawaii; Relatives of Others Await News

One South Jersey Army officer and his family have been reported safe in the Hawaii war zone bombed Sunday by Japanese planes but parents of numerous other service men and civilians are still anxiously awaiting word concerning their safety in the battle of the Pacific.

So far the casualty lists released by the War and Navy Departments at Washington have not revealed

the names of any South Jersey civilians, service men or their families. Parents, relatives and sweethearts continued their inquiries last night about the safety of their loved ones after the bombing of Hawaii and the Philippines.

The first service man with his family to be reported safe was Capt. Charles Harlow Miles, of Wenonah, who is at Hickam Field,
