

LOCOMOBILE RAN AWAY

Fred Bennett Probably Fatally Injured at Binghamton, N. Y.

Binghamton, N. Y., May 11.

Fred Bennett, son of Abe Bennett, was injured, it is feared fatally, last night by a runaway locomobile. Bennett had recently purchased the machine.

Last evening he started for a short run about the city with a friend. While passing along Water street the machine became unmanageable. At increasing speed it rushed along the crowded thoroughfare, crossing from side to side of the street in a zig-zag course. It turned a corner neatly and avoided an approaching team, but suddenly dashed into the curb while going at the rate of forty miles an hour. The occupants were thrown out. Bennett landed on his head and was picked up unconscious. It was found he had sustained concussion of the brain. The machine was uninjured.
