

Roy Bolig Now in Africa

A letter confirming their belief that he was in Africa was received last week from Master Sergeant Roy V. Bolig by his family at Selinsgrove, R. D.

Bolig gave an indication that he is in the midst of the fighting in the Dark Continent when he wrote that he and his buddies were "busy" all the time. For military reasons, he is unable to say specifically what his duties are.

Written about Nov. 25, the letter was mailed before Bolig knew of the death of his father, M. Luther Bolig. The Red Cross has been assigned the duty of contacting him overseas with word of his father's demise.

The sun is so terribly hot where he is stationed that many of the boys are blistered, and the general attire for the soldiers is shorts. They are spending much of the time in the bush, have no conveniences and infrequent opportunities to shave and wash.

At the time the letter was written, Bolig said he had not received any of the articles which his family had sent him.

Bolig was one of the greatest athletes ever turned out in Selinsgrove high school, and won himself a place at other schools after finishing his studies here. He is a brother of Harold L. Bolig, coach and director of athletics at the high school.
