

**SCHOOL AT WENONAH  
TO RE-OPEN MONDAY**

Wenonah, Nov. 16.—For the second time since classes started in September, the Wenonah school is being fumigated and scrubbed with disinfectants as the result of a local outbreak of scarlet fever. The school was closed yesterday by order of the Board of Health and school officials and it will not reopen until next Monday.

"Sunshine and fresh air will help up speedily check this latest outbreak," said Dr. Harry Schiesser, president of the health board, today. "The malady has been so light as to puzzle us and made it difficult to effect a true diagnosis until the patients started to peel. This may be responsible for the continuation of the disease in the school over a period of several weeks. We are having medical examinations made daily of all pupils when the school is open."
