

WENONAH CLOSES WITH WIN OVER NATIONAL

WENONAH, N. J., Nov. 17.

WENONAH Military Academy closed its football season yesterday afternoon by beating the National Farm School, 27 to 0. The cadets played on their own field before a large crowd of visitors and the majority of the players were seniors, playing their last game and there were many excellent plays.

The feature plays of the game were the long end runs by nearly every member of the backfield. It was the runs that were responsible for the scores. Brodie made the first score when he crossed the goal line from the one-yard line after Pizzano made a 25-yard run. Zanger kicked a placement for the extra point. Pizzano intercepted a forward pass on Wenonah's 40-yard line and Boote took it over from the 10-yard line after a 25-yard run around right end. Brodie failed to kick the extra point.

Brodie got loose and carried the ball to the one-yard line and Ness went through centre for the third touchdown, and Brodie added the extra point by a drop kick. Schwartz blocked a punt on Farm School's 40-yard line and recovered the ball and carried it for five yards. On a trick play, Wallace skirted left end for the last score.
