

PIZZANO HERO OF WENONAH VICTORY OVER PENNINGTON

WENONAH, N. J., Oct. 20. WENONAH MILITARY ACADEMY triumphed over Pennington in a fierce, gruelling and hectic tilt on Wenonah field yesterday afternoon that was finally decided in the favor of the former by the score of 13-6.

The score of this fray just about tells the tale of the classic battle that was waged on Wenonah's historic field. Pennington took the lead right at the start of the fracas by virtue of the forward pass attack which they are masters of. That time worn play, in which the end hides at the end of the field, proved successful and on a long toss from Irwin, Harris crossed the line, scoring the first touchdown, drawing first blood for his school and throwing a big scare into the hopes of the Military lads.

But Wenonah showed that they possess a goodly portion of the pristine pluck by coming back in fine style to reverse the tables and turn the tide of victory in their own favor. It takes men worthy of a good foeman's steel to do this little thing, but Wenonah showed that they do not know the meaning of the word quit and that incidentally they have the men to turn the trick that spells victory.

To tell the story of the victory is to recount the valiant deeds of Pizzano, and that is the thing which we are going to do.

In the very first period he started off rather auspiciously by successfully completing a forward pass that gained thirty yards and put them within striking distance of their opponent's goal line. The play was recalled because of holding, and on an exchange

of punts Pennington again found themselves in the same place.

On this occasion they did not lose their golden chance to score, but made their hopes a concrete realization by scoring that famous touchdown in the manner narrated before. The try for point after touchdown proved unsuccessful, as Holton rushed through in time to block the kick. And now the rest of the story could well be termed the comeback of Wenonah, because that is the thing that they did. In the second period they started an unstoppable offensive when Pizzano slipped off tackle for ten yards; the same play against the other side gained the same distance, and now, within the shadow of their goal line, Pennington made a commendable effort to hold, but all in vain. Wenonah was not to be denied as was seen when the irrepressible Pizzano rushed around the end to score.

It was the same old story in the third period, when Pizzano's might again asserted itself. After carrying the elusive spheroid all the way down the field through his own brilliant efforts, Pizzano slipped off tackle for eighteen yards, a score which meant two things, the victory of Wenonah and the defeat of the invader.
