

## Rogers Attends Langston Rites In Wenonah

NEW YORK (UPI)—U.S. Secretary of State William P. Rogers canceled a string of diplomatic appointments, and was spending today at memorial services for his brother-in-law at Wenonah, N.J.

The services were for Bryant W. Langston and his wife, who were killed in the crash of a small aircraft. Langston was the brother of Mrs. Rogers.

Because of the services, Rogers was unable to attend the U.N. General Assembly, where Soviet foreign minister Andrei A. Gromyko was one of the key speakers. Rogers sent Gromyko a note expressing regret over not listening in person to the Soviet official's speech, U.S. sources said.
